- □ Enrollment Packet
- ☐ Proof of D.C. Residency
 - The parent or guardian who signs and fill out the enrollment form will be required to provide proof of D.C. residency.

You will need one of the following to prove D.C. residency

- A paystub, issued within 45 days prior to school's review of residency documentation, showing your D.C. address and D.C. tax withholding.
 Supplemental Security Income annual benefits notification.
- ☐ Verification letter and Military Housing orders; or Deers Statement.
- ☐ An embassy letter indicating embassy sponsored housing in D.C. with embassy seal affixed.
- ☐ Unexpired official documentation of financial assistance from the DC Government including TANF, Medicaid, SCHIP, SSI, housing assistance or other DC Government Programs.
- ☐ A copy of D-40 form verified by the D.C. office of Tax & Revenue form.
- ☐ Proof that the child is a ward of the District of Columbia, in the form of a Court Order.

If you do not have one of the above you will need <u>two</u> of the following:

- ☐ Unexpired D.C. motor vehicle registration.
- ☐ Unexpired D.C. motor vehicle operator's permit or official non-driver identification.
- ☐ Unexpired lease with proof of payment within 2 months preceding school's review of residency documents.
- Utility bill (only gas, electric and water bills are acceptable) with receipt of payment within 60 days (2 months) of school's review of residency documentation.
